### **2021 Summer Camp Basic Information:**

- In order to be eligible to attend Nordonia Drama summer camps, **students must be entering grades 2 through 9** in the fall of 2021.
- All students will receive a part in the show, but they will still need to go through the audition process. Students should be prepared to sing an audition song for the 1<sup>st</sup> day of camp. The type of song is up to your child; it should be no more than 30-60 seconds long.
- Daily camp rehearsals run from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm.
- On the Thursday and Friday of the second week of camp, we will run from 9:00 am until 4:00 pm as we prepare the show for performance.
- **We do ask that campers avoid any peanut products in their snacks and lunches due to food allergies.**
- Our camp will put on a final performance of their musical for family on the last day of camp.

- Full tuition payment will be due upon arrival to the first day of camp on July 19<sup>th</sup>.
